God calls us in many ways to do His work. We never thought God would call us to create an alternative to commercially made women's clergy shirts.

We traveled to Uganda to meet with Bishop Wilson Mutebi and the ladies from Ebenezer Ministries' sewing class, a program jointly sponsored by Grace Church, Wilmington, Delaware, and the Anglican Church in Mityana, Uganda. Under the expert instruction of Teo Namississi and seed money from Grace and Good Samaritan Orphanage Charity, these women have produced a high-quality, fitted women's clergy shirt.

This beautiful clergy blouse, with flattering fit and expert tailoring, is made from high quality fabric, with vertical darts front and back, topstitching, front placket and French seams finishing on the inside. Fabric is cotton for comfort and rayon for softness and shape. Matching buttons are chosen by the women's sewing class and may vary. Machine wash and light iron.



All proceeds go to Ebenezer Ministries to supply educational expenses for orphaned children in Uganda. How often can you do ministry and dress well at the same time?
